Delegate costs for students and teachers at FN-skolor: FN-skolor are allowed to send one student delegation á four + one teacher as an additional choice to our basic package. This includes the conference, material, accommodation in a shared room and all meals. If you wish to send extra delegates or teachers they will have to pay a fee of 1400 SEK per person for the conference, material, accommodation and all meals.

Delegate costs for student and teachers that do not belong to an official UN-school: 690 SEK – includes the conference, material and food (except breakfast).

Accommodation is not included, but you are more than welcome to contact UNA Sweden for more information about where you can stay in Falun.
